- 8/24** :: 1 Corinthians 11:1
Follow my example, as I follow the example of Christ.

- 8/31** :: 2 Corinthians 5:20
We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us. We implore you on Christ's behalf: Be reconciled to God.

- 9/7** :: Mark 1:35
Very early in the morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house and went off to a solitary place, where he prayed.

- 9/14** :: Psalm 119:11

- 9/21** :: Proverbs 28:13
